Welcome to our Practice. We aim to offer a full range of health services to you and your family, in a friendly and efficient environment. If you wish to register, please ask the receptionist for the relevant forms. All we ask in return is that you keep your appointment, or cancel it giving as much notice as possible and to behave civilly to our staff. Abusive behaviour will **not** be tolerated and will result in you being asked to register elsewhere.

Reception Hours

Reception and telephones are open from 8:00am – 6:30pm
Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday
Wednesday 8:00am – 1:30pm

Routine Appointments

Daily surgeries 8:30am – 11:00am &
3:30pm – 6:00pm (except Wednesday)

Please make an appointment in advance by telephone or in person with the doctor or nurse of your choice.

Confidentiality

This practice is fully computerised and registered under the Data Protection Act. Patient confidentiality is a major priority and patients, relatives and carers are asked to remember this when making enquiries which may put staff in a difficult position. We can only discuss a patient with a third party if we have their express consent in writing.

Online Facilities

Once you have registered with us, you can apply to view parts of your medical record, book appointments and request repeat prescriptions online via our website (www.barnessurgery.co.uk) This is a simple procedure that requires you to spend a few moments setting yourself up with the required passwords. Please ask one of the reception staff for more details.

Emergency Appointments

If a problem is urgent, we will try to see you on the same day. You will be fitted in as soon as possible or asked to come back later. Please be patient if you have to wait. You must telephone before arriving at the surgery, as we do not offer any walk-in appointments.

Home Visits

If you are too unwell to attend the surgery, the doctor may visit you at home after triaging your symptoms. Please telephone before 11:00am, so that the doctors can plan their rounds. Please be prepared to give your name, address, telephone number and a brief summary of the problem to the receptionists.

Out of Hours Emergencies

Emergency cover is provided by a service whose number is 03000 240000, this is repeated when you call the normal surgery number. The operator will take your details and arrange for a telephone consultation or a home visit or you may be directed to a walk-in centre. Alternatively, advice can be obtained from the NHS by dialling **111**.

The Walk-in Centre at Teddington Memorial Hospital is open 8:00am - 10:00pm Monday to Friday and 8:00am - 9:00pm weekends and Bank Holidays. They can help with minor ailments and injuries, emergency contraception or give advice re self help. Telephone 020 8741 4004. They do not however issue repeat prescriptions.

Telephone Advice

You can speak to the doctor for advice, preferably between 10:30am and 11:30am. Depending on workload, it may be necessary for the receptionist to take your number for the doctor to call you back – please make sure you stay by your telephone in this case.

Results

Test results may be obtained over the telephone from the receptionist, please call from 1:30pm - 3:30pm to avoid the busy surgery times. If there is a problem with a test result, the surgery will make every effort to contact you.

Repeat Prescriptions

Requests can be made in writing by:

- Post
- Fax
- Delivered in person
- Ordered over the internet [please ask staff for details]
- Verbally asked for at Reception

Please tick the appropriate box on the computer printout attached to your last prescription.

Please allow at least two clear working days (not including weekends and bank holidays). If you wish the prescription to be posted to you, please provide a stamped addressed envelope. Our Staff cannot take requests over the telephone, therefore please do not wait until you run out to request repeat medication; and please do not put them in an awkward situation by asking.

In some cases, it may be possible to arrange request and collection by a local pharmacy - please ask about this at the pharmacy of your choice, the surgery cannot do this on your behalf.

Ante-Natal and Post-Natal Clinics: by appointment with any Doctor.

Family Planning and cervical smear tests: By appointment with either female doctor (family planning) or in any session held by the Practice Nurse (cervical smears).

Physiotherapy: for a range of conditions, please ask the doctor for a referral.

Counselling: Ask the Doctor for details and referral as appropriate.

Older Persons Clinic: Annual checkups and advice for Older Persons are carried out by our Doctors or Nurse. Home visits can be arranged for the housebound only.

Travel Immunisation and Advice

Please book with the Practice Nurse.

Suggestions and Complaints

If you have any problems with the service provided or any suggestions for improvements, please make these known in person or in writing to the Practice Manager. Alternatively, do use the suggestion box situated at the turn of the stairs. Compliments are very welcome too!

Training

Occasionally a medical student will visit the Practice and patients may be asked if a student can be present during a consultation or if they are willing to be interviewed by him or her.

Parking and Access

We do not offer parking facilities, however on-street parking is available on the side road opposite (Baronsmead Road). There is a rear entrance to the surgery for wheelchair users (only with prior notice) and there is limited space for prams and pushchairs to be left in the communal hallway and porch (they are not permitted inside the surgery due to lack of space and the stairs down to the consulting rooms).

Private Services

Some services are not available under the NHS, eg insurance forms, certain medicals and signing of housing and Driving Licenses etc. A fee will be charged according to BMA guidelines.
